Western China Seminars and Workshop in 2024

From 19-23 June, 2024, Western China Seminars and Workshop were carried out in two provinces in western and middle parts of China, with about 100 attendees. Each of these seminars was held inside the host hospital, with relevant questions and answers, live demonstrations and patient consultations.

The hosts of these events regularly treat large numbers of patients at each hand surgery unit with 10-20 attending hand surgeons. They have greatly benefited from such an education format. Workshops were focused on tendon repair techniques, splint making and rehabilitation methods after flexor and extensor tendon repairs.

Among the faculties at the Western China Seminars and Workshop were Drs. Jin Bo Tang, Jing Chen, Qing Zhong Chen and Shu Guo Xing from The Affiliated Hospital of Nantong University, Nantong, Jiangsu, and Dr. Xiao Ju Zhen from Xian Fengcheng Hospital of Xian City. The project leaders were Drs. Jing Chen and Qian Qian Yang, and Zhen coordinated the hosts of these hospitals. IFSSH sponsored the transportation to these hospitals for this project. This project will be repeated in the future.



5TH ACU MEETING & 10TH JIXIA FORUM HELD IN HANGZHOU, JUNE 8-9, 2024

June 2024 was a busy month for the colleagues of the Association of Chinese-speaking Hand Surgeons United (ACU). The 10th Jixia Forum and the 5th ACU Meeting were held on 8 and 9 June in the city of Hangzhou, attended by both on-site and online attendees. As a tradition of this Forum, ample time was reserved for discussion after each presentation. The format of the Forum of this year was expanded to include on-site journal clubs, presentations about senior influential hand surgeons (Drs. De Shi and Cheng Qi Wang), who contributed to hand surgery development a few decades ago. The Forum also included reviews and presentations of recent activities of ACU colleagues in international congresses and courses.

The night session was another highlight of this Forum, being from 7:30 to 10:30 pm, with presentations from 4 active hand surgeons followed by case discussion. Coffee, beer, and snacks were provided at the back of the conference hall to offer a more relaxing and enjoyable atmosphere of this night session. Microsurgical lymphatic surgery was a major topic in the evening session by our host, Dr. You Mao Zhen, an expert and active investigator on lymphatic surgery. The 5th ACU Congress was held the next day, with peripheral nerve compression, PIP joint fractures, and metacarpal fractures as main symposium topics, and free papers covering all aspects of hand surgery. Two major lectures were given by our Taiwanese colleague (Dr. Ren Tian Shi) of Taipei on wrist surgery and by an expert on pediatric hand surgery (Dr. Xiao Fei Tian).

ACU Colleagues Attended FESSH Congress in Rotterdam


